Combined with the free will collection of the evening, donations are made to further the goals of justice and equality, especially within the Arlington Public Schools. Revenue for the 2019 Observance was \$4,591.57. Expenses for printing, music, speaker, custodian, postage, etc., were \$2,376.36. MLK Committee donations were: \$1,500 to the Arlington African American Scholarship Fund for three awards to Arlington High School students; \$198 to the Tree of Life Synagogue; \$198 to Hebrew Immigrant Aide Society; \$750 to the Boston Foundation for the Boston King Memorial; \$100 for Arlington International Film Festival's student film award; \$100 to the Housing Corporation of Arlington.

The next MLK meetings are November 20<sup>th</sup> and December 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:15pm in the Senior Center, 1<sup>st</sup> floor art room. We would welcome you or someone you know to join with us. Thank you for your support and we look forward to seeing you on Monday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
