MISSION AND JUSTICE MINSTRY

HYGIENE SUPPLIES DRIVE, 125th ANNIVERSARY EDITION

The Mission & Justice Ministry invites you to participate in our first quarter hygiene supplies drive of 2024! This year, we're teaming up with the 125th Anniversary Committee. We met our goal for January and donated 125 cans of soup to Arlington Eats!

For February, we will collect supplies to create Period Kits for Church World Services (CWS). Last year we sent 39 kits in February and 54 kits in May as well as additional non-period kit supplies to the Somerville Homeless Coalition in February and November.


On Sunday, February 28, 2024, PACC gained two new members.

LENTEN STUDY SERIES 2024: The Abrahamic Faiths


